

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ROBBINSVILLE, IN THE COUNTY OF MERCER, NEW JERSEY REAPPROPRIATING \$250,000.00 OF PROCEEDS OF OBLIGATIONS NOT NEEDED FOR THEIR ORIGINAL PURPOSES FOR OTHER CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND PURPOSES**

BE IT ORDAINED, By The Township Council Of The Township Of Robbinsville, In The County of Mercer, New Jersey (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) as follows:

Section 1: Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:2-39, it is hereby determined that \$250,000.00 of the proceeds of obligations originally made available pursuant to the following ordinances of the Township of Robbinsville, in the County of Mercer, New Jersey (the "Township") are no longer necessary for the purposes for which the obligations previously were authorized. Each amount is listed under the column, "Balance to be Reappropriated," and is further described by reference to the number of the bond ordinance pursuant to which such amount has been made available, and the description of the improvement for which such amounts originally were appropriated. The \$250,000.00 proceeds to be reappropriated are made available as follows:

Section 2: The aggregate sum of \$250,000.00 is hereby reappropriated from the bond ordinance referred to in Section 1 hereof as follows:

Acquisition of Real Property-16 School Drive, Windsor, NJ, Block 13, Lot 24	250,000.00
<b>TOTAL</b>	<u>\$250,000.00</u>

Section 3: The capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, Department of Community Affairs, State of New Jersey is on file with the Township Clerk and is available for public inspection

Section 4: The improvements authorized hereby are not current expenses and are general improvements that the Township may lawfully make. No part of the cost of the improvements authorized hereby has been or shall be specially assessed on any property specially benefited thereby.

Section 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 6: This bond ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
